



Scholarship Recipient Nomination Form

We are pleased to announce that Up with People, the world-renowned international education, arts and service organization, will be awarding a **\$3000 Up with People/Stage One Scholarship** to one female and one male participant from each of the Spring 2012 Regional Stage One Dance Competitions.

As the owner or director of a studio competing in one of our Regional Competitions, *you are eligible to nominate up to two female and two male dancer participants to receive this scholarship award*, announced during the awards ceremony at the culmination of each competition.

How to nominate:

- *Your select nominee must be a current high school junior or senior, or high school graduate under the age of 29, and must be performing a solo at the Stage One Dance Competition.*
- Complete the "Nomination Form" (below) and FAX or MAIL it to Stage One offices no later than one week prior to your team's competition date. Alternatively, you can bring the nomination form to the competition, but it must be turned in on the first day of registration.
- Notify your nominees that they will be considered for this award. Give the bottom portion of the Nomination Form to the nominee and ask them to bring this, and a photo, to the competition.

The Scholarship Award:

- Participation in the Up with People (UWP) Global Education Program, and therefore use of the scholarship, is dependent upon the applicant's successful completion of the application process and acceptance to travel. An online application and personal interview are required.
*Auditions are not required. Performing arts ability is preferred but not mandatory for travel in UWP.
- The current UWP program fee is \$16,950 for a semester and \$24,950 for a year. (Fees are subject to change). Stage One scholarship recipients will be eligible to apply for additional scholarship assistance.

Up with People offers an unparalleled way to experience the world through international travel, performing arts and community service. UWP brings together 100 participants from 20+ countries for a one or two semester multi-continent tour, beginning every January and July. Founded in 1965, the UWP alumni network is made up of more than 20,000 people from 70 countries.

Cast members make a lasting positive impact on the communities they visit through dynamic stage performances, hands-on service projects and host family stays. Participants also gain leadership skills, cultural competency and a life experience intended to launch a future full of possibility and opportunity. University credit is also available.

The ideal Up with People participant will demonstrate an interest in all the main aspects of the program. Participants must be between the ages of 17 and 29 and can tour for one or two semesters. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis for the next three available enrollment dates.

- Complete the "Nomination Form" (below) and FAX or MAIL it to Stage One offices no later than one week prior to your team's competition date. Alternatively, you can bring the nomination form to the competition, but it must be turned in on the first day of registration.
- Notify your nominees that they will be considered for this award. Give the bottom portion of the Nomination Form to the nominee and ask them to bring this, and a photo, to the competition.

The Scholarship Award:

- The scholarship must be used in either the summer of 2012 or 2013.
- The current Camp UWP fee is \$2,600, for the 2012 camp session.
- The 2012 dates are: Cast A – July 1 to 21; or Cast B – July 22 to August 11

Camp Up with People is a non-profit 3-week performing arts summer camp that brings together young people from around the world to impact and inspire the community through service and song. It's a collaborative effort between Horizons Learning Foundation and Up with People in an effort to reach high-school aged youth (ages 14-17) interested in performing arts, leadership and global citizenship.

The purpose of Camp Up with People is to provide young people with an opportunity to explore their interests, develop their talents, and experience what traveling with Up with People would be like, and to create a safe, caring environment where young people can make friends, have fun and achieve personal growth.

Through outdoor activities, service projects and learning and performing a professionally produced show, campers will gain a sense of social responsibility, as well as the skills and appreciation of working cooperatively as part of a diverse group. Each session will culminate with an on-stage capstone public performance.

Camp Up with People is located in the heart of the beautiful Shenandoah Valley of Virginia, approximately two hours from Washington D.C.
